



Constantine Mining Scholarship Program

The Constantine Mining Scholarship Program is designed to help graduating high school seniors in the Chilkat Valley (Haines, Klukwan and Homeschool) reach their advanced education goals. Funds can be used for vocational training programs as well as undergraduate degrees. The field of study in either program must relate to resource development.

Resource development related fields of study include, but are not limited to:

Accounting	Administration	Public/Community Relations
Cooking	Drilling	Engineering
Environment	First Aid, EMT, Nurse	Geology
Human Resources	Logistics	Equipment Operator
Safety	Surveying	Trades

Scholarship Details: There are two, \$500 multiyear scholarship awards available.

- One for a student pursuing a 4-year undergraduate degree at an accredited post-secondary university or academic institution
- One for a student enrolling in a one or 2-year vocational training program at an accredited post-secondary education center
- Annual awards will continue until program completion as long as the student maintains a cumulative 2.5 GPA, takes a full course load, and completes their study within the set program timeframe. Additional years of funding may be added upon appeal.

Eligibility: Scholarships are open to graduating high school seniors in the Chilkat Valley (Klukwan, Haines, or Homeschool). Midyear graduates are also eligible.

Selection Criteria: The Constantine Mining Scholarship Committee will base award decisions on the following criteria:

- Personal Character
- Personal Achievement
- Scholastic or Vocational Achievements
- Public Service
- Financial Need
- In-Person Interview

Application Requirements:

- Completed Application
- High School Transcript
- Two or more letters of recommendation (one from a teacher and the other from someone not related to the student)
- An interview with the Constantine Mining Scholarship Committee (scheduled following receipt of the completed application)
- Proof of application to or letter of acceptance from a post-secondary education institution



Application Submission and Deadlines:

- The 2020 deadline for completed Scholarship applications to be received either online at info@constantinemetals.com or at the Constantine Mining office (120 N 2nd Ave., Haines, AK) is **5pm AKDT on Friday April 10, 2020.**
- Award recipients will be announced on the Haines High School graduation day in May, 2020.

Funding Mechanism: Funds will be paid directly to a school/program administration and credited to the student's account. If tuition has already been paid, the student will be reimbursed upon proof of payment.

Multiyear Awards: To receive funding for subsequent years, the student must submit a current transcript showing a 2.5 GPA or higher and proof of registration for the upcoming term/ program.

Limitation of Support: Scholarship support is provided on a year-to-year basis based on funding availability. Multiyear scholarships already awarded will be fully funded, but new scholarships may be limited.
